If your personal hygiene becomes a concern at the center, you may be asked to address the situation. We understand that this may be an embarrassing situation to face, but our goal is to maintain a safe, sanitary and comfortable environment for all members, visitors and staff of the Susquehanna Senior Center.

A speaker will be visiting the center on March 6 at 10:30. With warmer weather approaching, body odors may become more common and noticeable, so please try to attend and learn some helpful hygiene hints.
